## Shilpamandira Admission Test SAT – 2020

### Important Instructions

- **Scheme of Examination for SAT - 2020**

The SAT-2020 will be conducted in 3 subjects “Mathematics”, “Physics” & “Chemistry” for admission of students to Diploma Courses through management quota. Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) will be set for all subjects which must be answered on specially designed machine readable answer sheets (OMR answer sheet). Answers are to be completely blackened by using **BLACK BALL POINT pen** only on the OMR sheet given. More than one answer indicated against one question will be treated as wrong answer.

- **Schedule of Examination**

Mathematics	– 50 marks
Physics	– 30 marks
Chemistry	– 20 marks
<i>Total</i>	<i>– 100 marks</i>

Time – 2 hour (MCQ – Multiple Choice Question)

Each question has one mark

**Negative marking: Each wrong answer has –0.5 marks**

- **Eligibility Criteria**

An Indian male citizen, having passed or appeared at the Secondary (Madhyamik) Examination of **the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education** or its equivalent having obtained with 50% marks in aggregate with English, Physical Science and Mathematics as subjects and at least 60% in Physical Science and Mathematics together. **Valid JEXPO-2020 Rank** is necessary for getting admission into the College.

- **Age Restriction**

The candidate must not be born before 01.01.1999 & should not be born after 30.06.2005.

- **Syllabus for SAT**

The revised syllabus of West Bengal Board of Secondary Education (WBBSE) for Madhyamik Pariksha, effective from the academic session 2019 – 20, will be followed. Syllabus and Question Pattern will be similar to JEXPO.

### **Instruction for Filling up of Application Form**

Item nos. 1 to 12 of Application Form must be filled-up in CAPITAL LETTERS in **Black ball point pen**:

- 1) **Full Name of the Applicant:** Fill the corresponding box for each letter. Give a gap of one box between the first name, middle name, and last name.
- 2) **Photo:** Paste two good quality recent colour photographs (3.5cm x 4.5cm) of applicant in proper place.
- 3) **Date of birth:** Fill in **dd/mm/yyyy** format by fill the corresponding box.
- 4) **Marks obtained in Madhyamik:** Specify the Full marks and Marks obtained in Mathematics and Physical Sciences, and Aggregate excluding optional subject in Madhyamik/Equivalent Examination.
- 5) **Year of Passing (Madhyamik):** Specify year of passing/appearing Madhyamik/Equivalent.
- 6) **Higher Secondary / Equivalent:** Specify year of passing/appearing and percentage marks secured.
- 7) **Name of guardian:** Fill in the name of legal guardian by giving a gap of one box between first name, middle name and last name.
- 8) **Mobile Number of Guardian:** Specify Mobile no and fill the corresponding box.
- 9) **Relation with Guardian:** Tick the appropriate box.
- 10) **Permanent Home Address:** Mention the complete postal address and the **mobile phone number of the Student**.
- 11) **Contact Email Id:** Email id of the Student.
- 12) **Background Info:** Fill in **occupation** details of the primary Guardian responsible for Candidate's education, the **family income per month**, and **travel time** to reach the college from permanent home address, along with the left hand thumb impression of the Applicant.
- 13) **Declaration:** Candidate and his Guardian to put their signatures in the space provided to confirm the truth of the information provided. (Do not sign in CAPITAL letters).

- **Submission of Application Form**

The application form, duly filled-in, is to be submitted to College on any working day [Except Sundays and College holidays] between 10:30 a.m. and 03:00 p.m. within 21 March 2020. For valid Application forms, Hall Ticket will be issued against payment of Exam Fees of ₹ 300/- (CASH only).

- **Special Instruction**

Candidate's Original documents need to be submitted along with the application. The documentary evidence in support of educational qualification needs to be produced by successful candidates at the time of counseling for admission.

- **Procedure for Conduct of examination**

- 1) Candidate must enter the examination hall 30 minutes before the start of the examination to receive general instructions for answering MCQ type questions.  
Candidate must bring with them SAT Hall Ticket and Black Ball Point Pen.
- 2) The Hall Ticket must be shown to the officer supervising the examination as and when asked for.
- 3) **Candidates will not be allowed to use calculator, cell phone or other electronic gadgets in the examination hall.**
- 4) **Rough work or any other type writing should not be done on the OMR sheet. Question paper may be used for the purpose of rough work.**
- 5) Violation of any instruction and adoption of any unfair means in the examination shall render the candidate liable for cancellation of his answer sheet and forfeiture of his claim for his admission and the concerned examinee will be handed over to the Police.

  - **Counselling:** Schedule will be announced in due course (tentatively in Middle of June, 2020). At the time of counseling candidate must bring the following documents (**Original + Self-attested photocopy**).
    - Admit Card of SAT (Hall Ticket), valid SAT 2020 rank printout & valid JEXPO 2020 rank printout
    - Admit Card of Madhyamik or Equivalent Exam (for Age proof)
    - Madhyamik or equivalent exam Marksheet.
    - HS Marksheet (if already completed).
- For admission, **Medical fitness certificate in prescribed format is to be submitted.**

#### Admission Fees & Charges\*

Candidates must pay following Charges for seat allotment (after counseling):

Counseling Charges & Prospectus	₹ 4,500
Seat Security Deposit	₹ 6,000
Semester Fees	₹ 18,000
Student Activities Fees per Semester	₹ 4,000

**Counseling Charge** may be paid by cash/DD at the time of counseling. If the candidate is offered a seat, the **Seat Security Deposit, Semester Fees** and **Student Activities Fees** (₹ 28,500/- total) must be deposited by Demand Draft within two days in favour of "**Ramakrishna Mission Shilpamandira**". Personal cheques are not accepted.

The admission process must be completed within 2 days of seat allocation, failing which the seat allotment will be forfeited.

**\* Subject to Revision**

A candidate's admission is liable to be cancelled even at a later time if subsequent scrutiny shows that the information submitted by the candidate is incorrect or false or if he is medically unfit.

Refund of fees for candidates withdrawing their admission will be based on Institute's Policies.
